- 2. Procurement of Goods or Services Involving \$50,000 More Alabama law mandates that there be public competition for purchases involving \$50,000 or more. Therefore, competitive, sealed bids are required if the items needed are not already covered by an existing University, state or cooperative contract.
- 3. Procurement of Professional Services
 The services of physicians, architects, engineers, landscape architects, land surveyors, geoscientists, attorneys, teachers, artists, appraisers, and other individuals, or business entities offering the services of those individuals, who possess a higherent geometric or specialized skill and knowledge where the experience and professional qualifications of the service provider are particularly relevant to the provision of the required service are not subject to the Competitive Bid and Small Purchiase p above.
